 - c. *By using the "Q/A" button during the meeting for written comments (limited to 200 words). All comments must be submitted at the beginning of the public comment section.*
 - d. *If you are participating via phone only, use *9 to "Raise your hand" and *6 to unmute or mute yourself when called to speak.*
 - e. *Please be aware that the meeting will be conducted via webinar format and the Commission will not be able to see the audience, only hear them.*
 - f. *All requests to speak must be submitted at the beginning of public comment.*
