- The State posted its “prisoner-adjusted” Census data on September 20th
- NDC is processing the data and will have an update on timing of the mapping tool rollout at the next meeting

Defining Communities of Interest

1st Question: what defines your community?

- ❑ Geographic Area, plus
- ❑ Shared issue or characteristic
 - ❑ *Shared social or economic interest*
 - ❑ *Impacted by city policies*
- ❑ Tell us “your community’s story”

2nd Question:

Would this community benefit from being “included within a single district for purposes of its effective and fair representation”?

- ❑ Or would it benefit more from having multiple representatives?

Definitions of Communities of Interest may not include relationships with political parties, incumbents, or political candidates.

Possible Neighborhoods / Communities Discussed at Last Meeting

- **Ganesha Park & areas around the Fairplex** – should these be kept together?
- Historic District
- **Downtown** – Should this area be kept together or split up among multiple districts?
- **Other** – Possible communities of interest around schools?

June 23, 2021	1 st Independent Redistricting Commission
Summer 2021	Mapping software released to the public.* *Estimated time
July 28, 2021	1 st Public Hearing Held prior to the release of draft maps
August 25, 2021	2 nd Public Hearing (held prior to the release of draft maps) Identify “neighborhoods,” “communities of interest,” and “secondary areas.” Mapping tools overview.
Around October 1, 2021	Redistricting data available. Census data will be released in mid- to late-August. California will release prisoner-adjusted redistricting data around October 1.
TBA	Proposed 3rd hearing
TBA	Maps due from the public.
TBA	Proposed 4th hearing.
TBA	Publish revised map(s)
TBA	Final Hearing and Commission to adopt District map. Must be submitted to LA County Registrar of Voters no later than April 17, 2022
