Map Submissions

- ❑ Pomona received 12 complete and population balanced maps

- ❑ In addition, the DistrictR tool received:

- ❑ 4 maps that are slightly out of population balance ($<1\%$ over the threshold)

- ❑ 3 maps that are substantially out of population balance ($>1\%$ over the threshold)

- ❑ 3 partial map submissions (e.g. 1 district drawn)

- ❑ 1 further identifiable community of interest

Redistricting Rules and Goals

1. Federal Laws

- Equal Population
- Federal Voting Rights Act
- No Racial Gerrymandering



2. California Criteria for Cities

1. **Geographically contiguous**
2. **Undivided neighborhoods and “communities of interest”**
(Socio-economic geographic areas that should be kept together)
3. **Easily identifiable boundaries**
4. **Compact**
(Do not bypass one group of people to get to a more distant group of people)

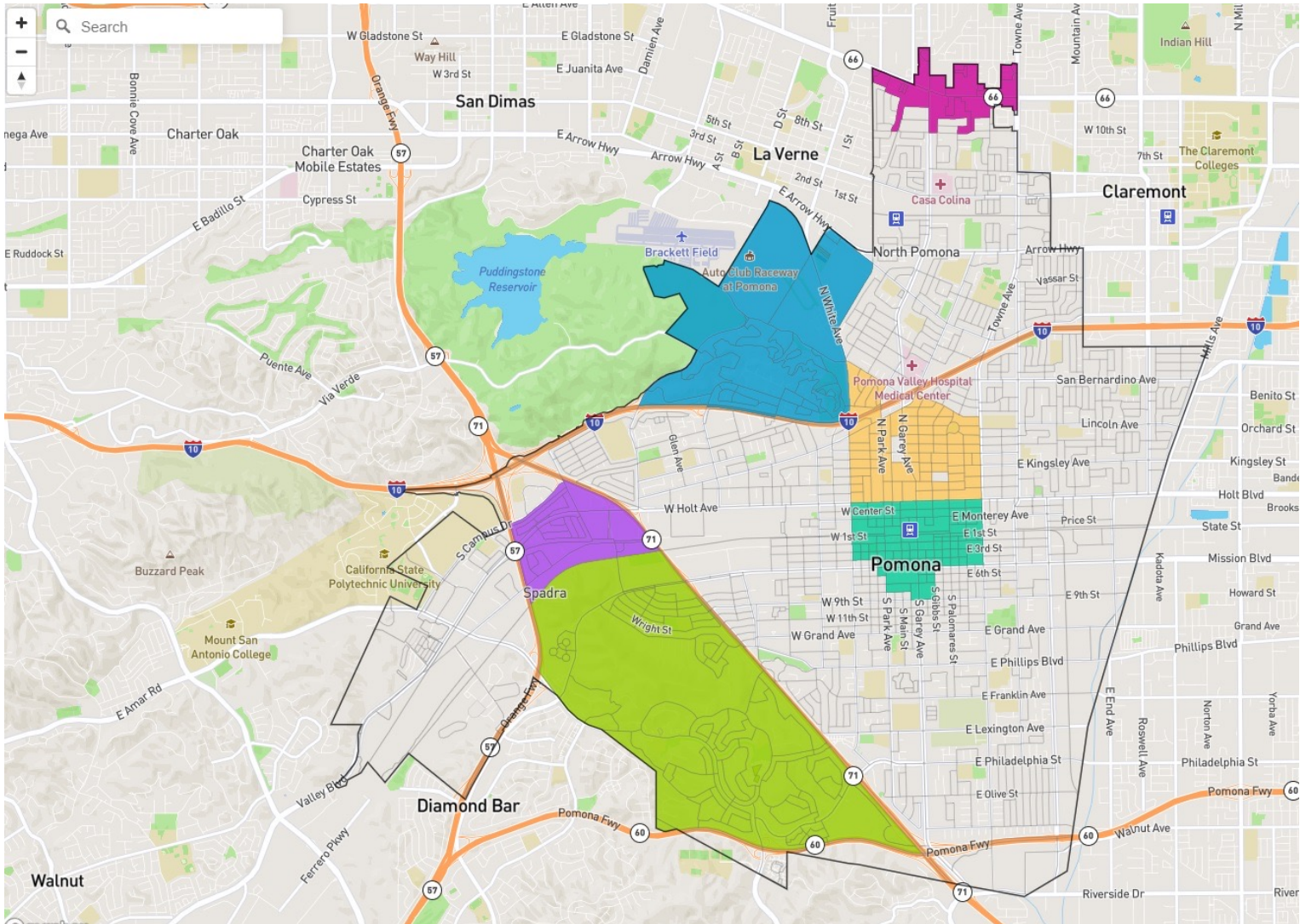
Prohibited:

Shall not favor or discriminate against an incumbent, a candidate, or a political party.

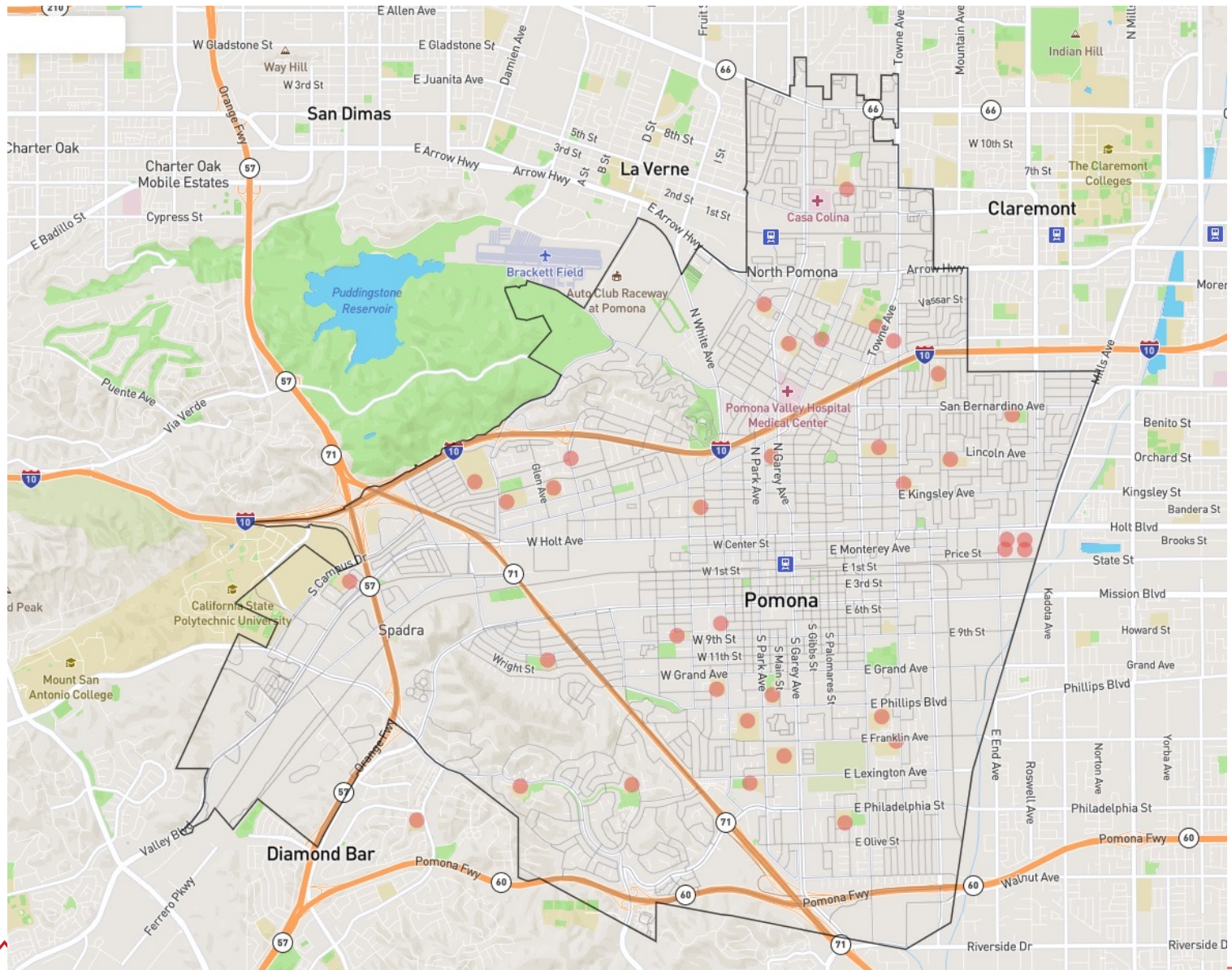
3. Other Traditional Redistricting Principles

- Minimize voters shifted to different election years
- Respect voters' choices / continuity in office
- Future population growth
- Preserving the core of existing districts

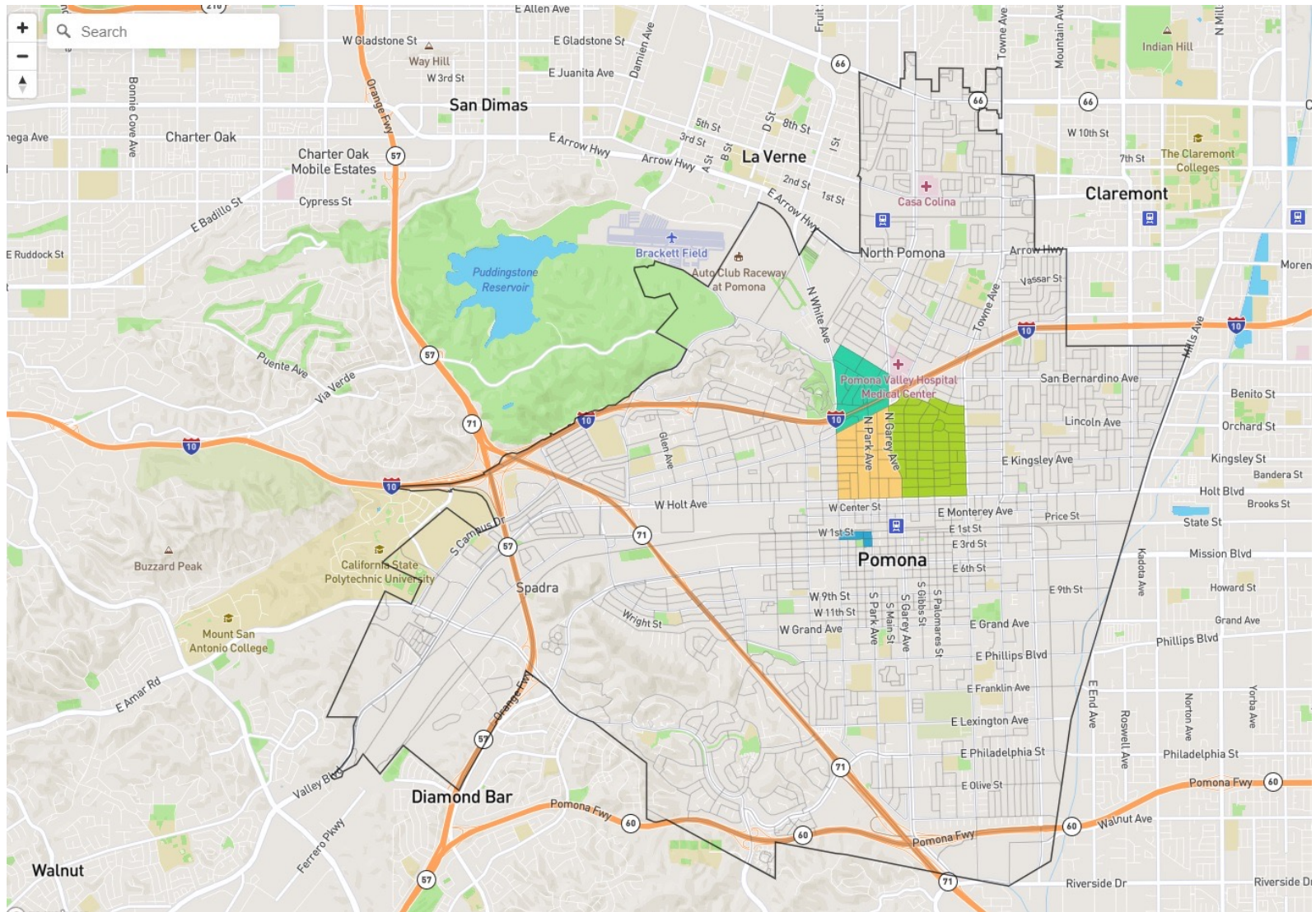
Potential Communities of Interest Map



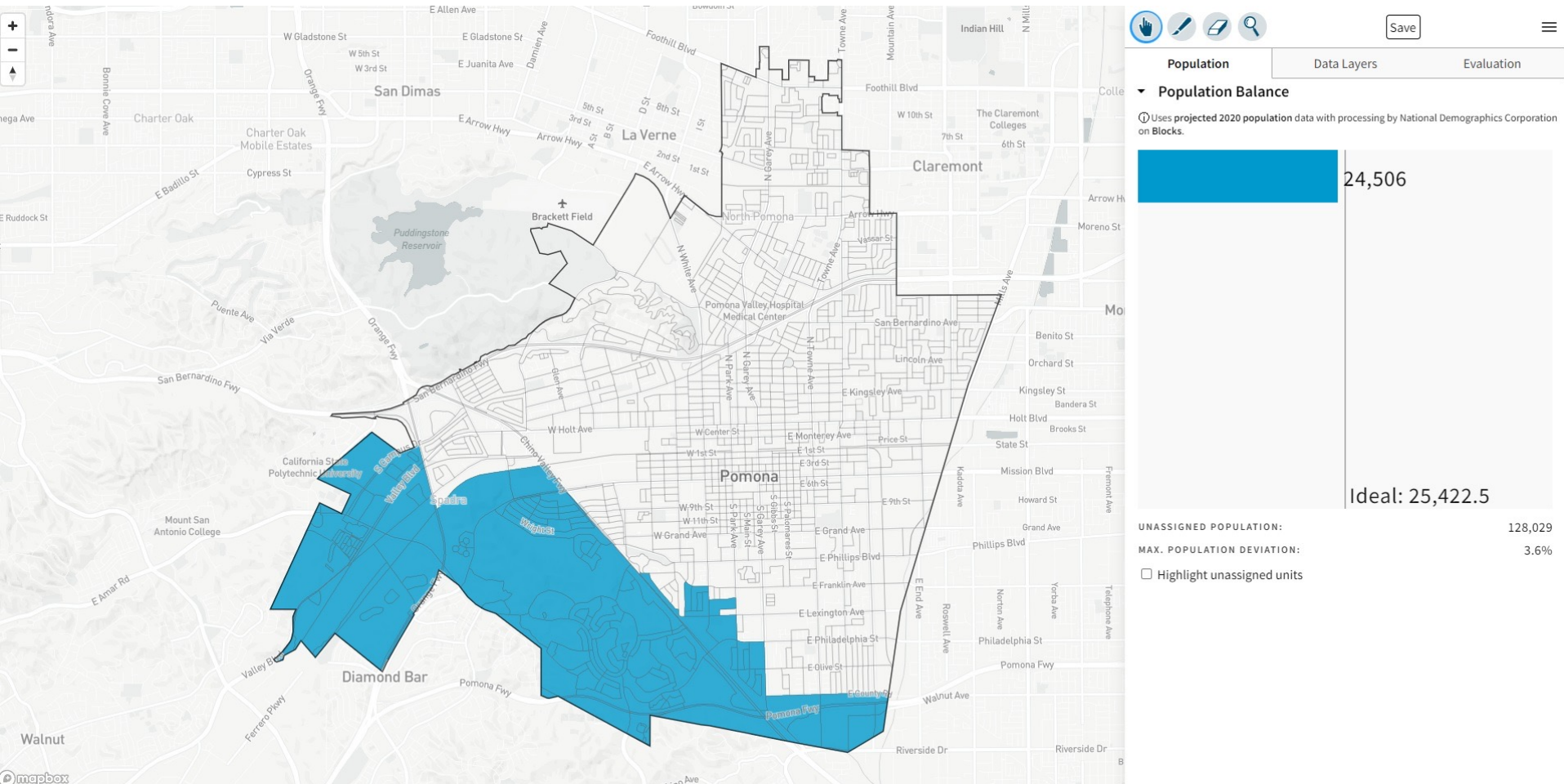
School Sites



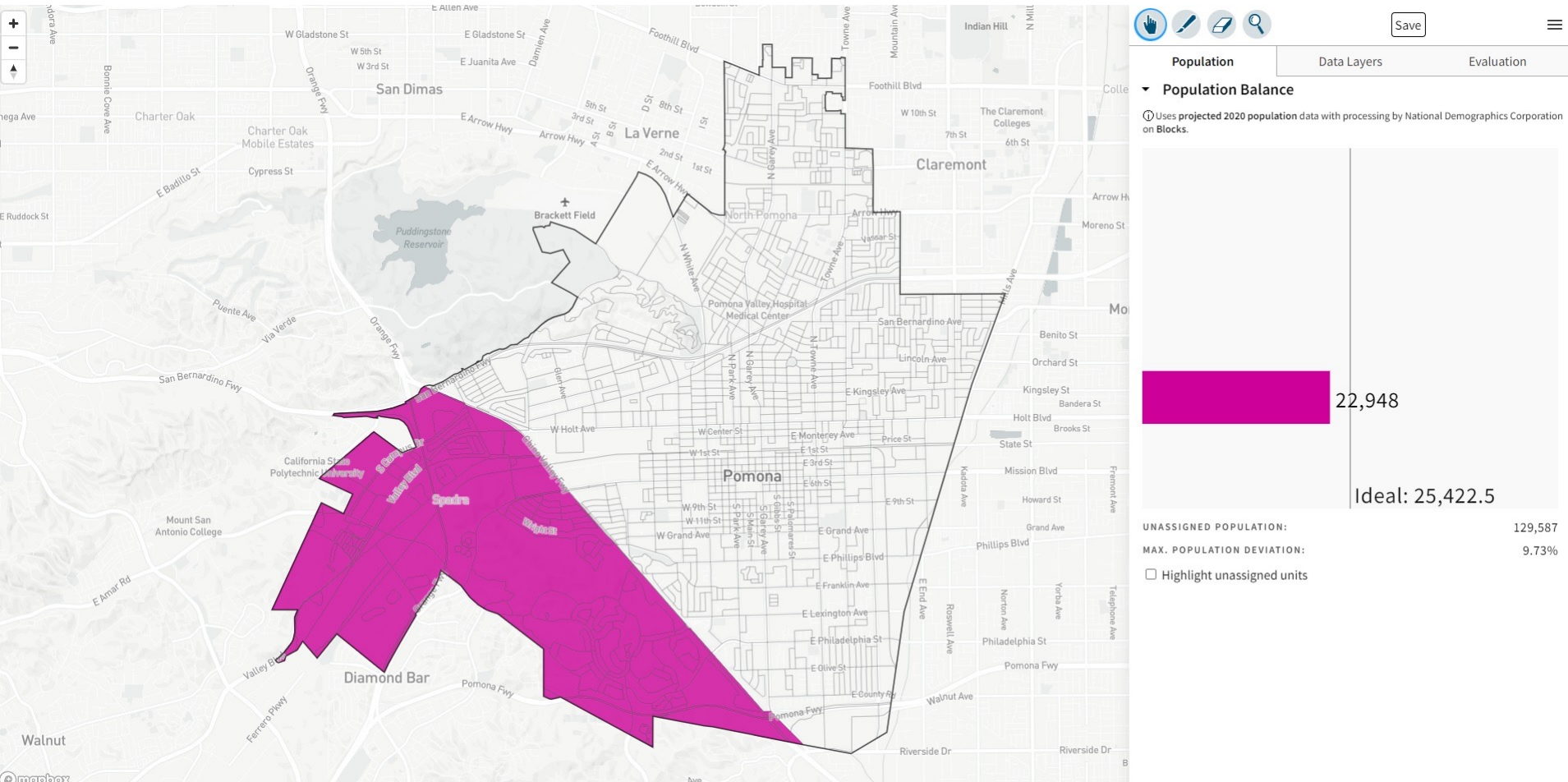
Historic Areas Submittal



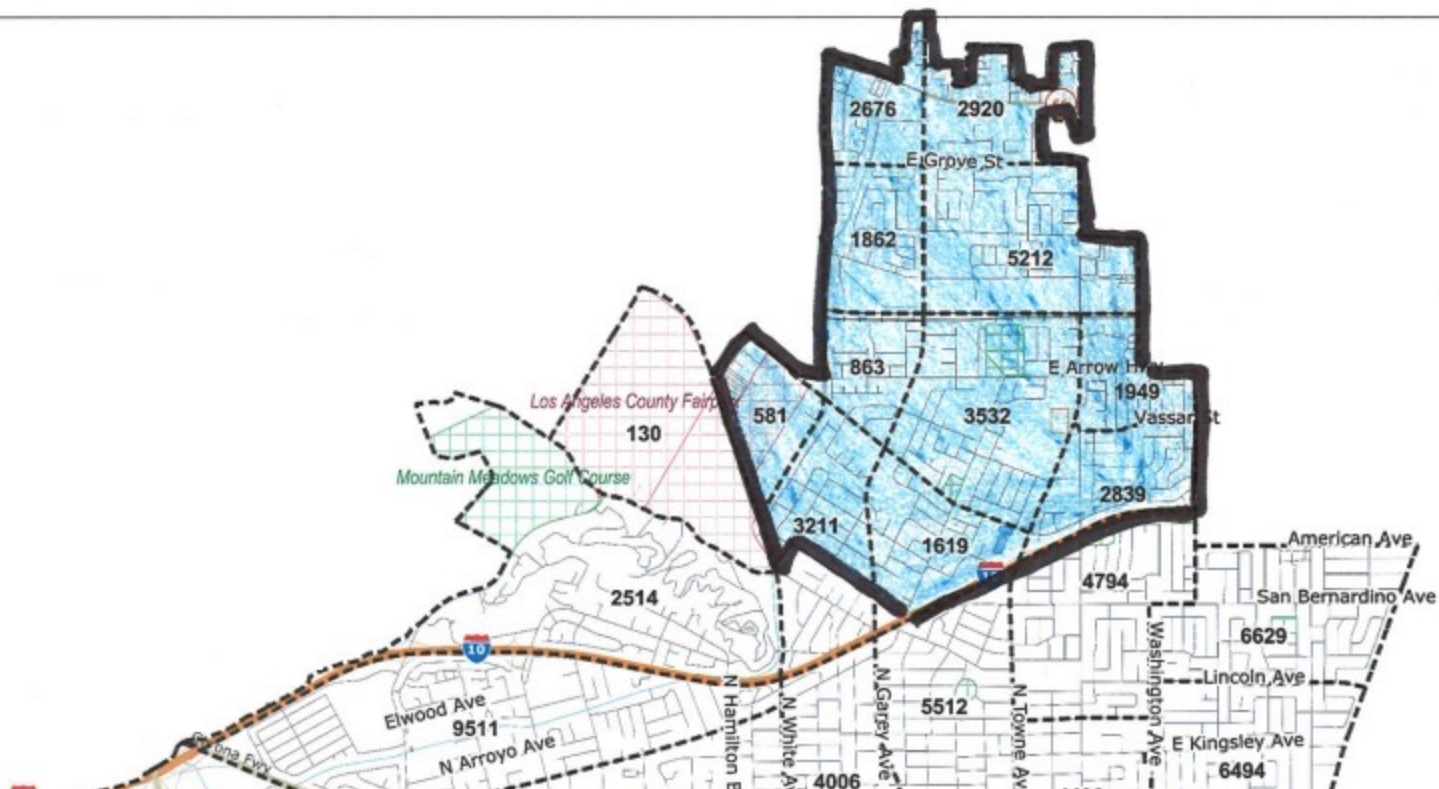
Partial District 1
